Description

The American Thyroid Association will award a limited number of travel grants (partial travel support) to North American Trainees (Clinical, Surgical, Post –doc, Doctoral) who have abstracts accepted to the 14th ITC program. The ATA has limited funds to partially support travel to the meeting who are the lead authors of regular abstract submissions.

Objective

To encourage trainees from North America to submit abstracts for and participate in the 14th International Thyroid Congress in Paris, France held 11-16 September 2010. The ITC is co-sponsored by the American Thyroid Association (ATA) along with the other 3 national thyroid societies. Each society has travel grants for its members who are trainees which is distinct from the ITC special travel awards to be announced at the ITC.

General policies and information

- Must be first author from North America on regular abstract submission (please provide acknowledgement email from the ITC).
- Applications must be received by June 30, 2010 (abstract deadline was May 2 – see <http://www.itc2010.com/abstracts.html>).
- Applications must be confirmed/endorsed by the Laboratory or Program Director.
- Applicants must have applied to be ATA members online at www.thyroid.org before sending travel grant application.
- Applications must submit all contact information by e-mail to thyroid@thyroid.org (confirm receipt) no later than June 30, 2010.
- Applicants must follow-up initial application by forwarding the e-mail abstract acceptance from the ITC to thyroid@thyroid.org (confirm receipt) no later than 1 week following receipt from the ITC.
- Award recipients will be approved by the ATA based on abstract rank.
- Only one grant per laboratory will be awarded (new applicants have priority).

Applications must include:

- The young investigator's name, date of birth, work and home address, phone numbers, and e-mail address (also provided in the online membership application)
- The abstract submission code number assigned in the e-mail message confirming receipt of the trainee's abstract.
- A confirmation letter from the Laboratory/Program Director including all contact information.
- A follow-up confirmation and copy of the acceptance email from the ITC.

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
